When it came time to make their Lowcountry wedding a reality, the couple worked closely with designer Jacin Fitzgerald who expertly combined natural details and foraged greenery with their coastal-inspired color palette. "Jacin helped us bring our vision to life by designing the perfect wedding to fit our personalities," says Stephanie.

When Stephanie and her girl squad visited Lovely Bride in Charleston, she knew she wanted a romantic, flowing gown that would allow her to dance throughout the

evening. "I went into my appointment with a totally different dress in mind, but as soon as I tried on my gown I knew it was the one," admits Stephanie. The show-stopper was an effortless Leanne Marshall dress with a halter top neckline, paired with a cathedral-length Rue De Seine veil and embellished belt from Untamed Petals.
